2024 Academic Scholarships MIDDLE SCHOOL (YEAR 7 & 8) AND SENIOR SCHOOL (YEAR 11 & 12)

Applications are invited for academic scholarships at Unity College commencing in 2024.

SENIOR SCHOOL

Unity College is offering academic scholarships for new or existing students at Year 11 or Year 12 in 2024 for part remission of tuition fees. The scholarship will be offered for two (2) years for students at Year 11 or one (1) year for students in Year 12.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Academic scholarships are awarded to Year 7 and Year 8 students for 2024. This scholarship provides partial remission of tuition fees for the student's five (5) or six (6) years of attendance at Unity College.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Application for scholarships must be made by completing and returning an application form and must include a written statement (of at least 500 words) from the student outlining their past achievements and future goals. A scholarship examination will be held on **Monday 11 September 2023 (TBC) from 4pm - 5.30pm in the Unity College Middle School Building**. The results of this examination form part of the basis of awarding students with scholarships.

Supporting evidence should be included with the application and may consist of one or more of the following:

- + School reports from previous two years
- + NAPLAN reports
- + Copies of academic certificates of achievement
- + Copies of sporting, music or other certificates of achievement
- + A reference from either a past teacher, Pastor, coach or mentor.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria will determine a successful applicant:

- + Unity College scholarship examination results
- + Demonstrated consistently strong academic performance in most subjects
- + Active involvement in co-curricular activities which may include, but are not limited to sport, debating or music
- + Leadership roles within the current school or wider community
- + Outstanding personal qualities
- + Positive contribution to the current school community in a variety of ways
- + An interview with the Principal for short-listed applicants.
